





For arriving passengers, the deplaning process and overall arrival experience will be much improved from existing TBIT with the use of three Passenger Boarding Bridges (PBB) for ADG VI gates. Arriving passengers will deplane the aircraft and enter a gate pier on Level 4 or Level 5 depending on the gauge of aircraft. Within each gate pier there is a stair, escalator and elevator to assist those passengers deplaning on the fourth level move up to the fifth level and into the sterile corridor. Passengers will travel down the sterile corridor towards the new Central Core for CBP processing and baggage claim.

As depicted on the backside of this insert, the new CBP Primary location is in the new Central Core on Level 3 and passengers will access the new CBP location via stair, escalator or elevator from new sterile corridor on Level 5 as shown above. Once processed through CBP Primary, passengers shall continue their descent to Level 1 via stair, escalator or elevator to baggage claim and CBP Secondary. The renovation of the existing TBIT baggage claim, which includes the entire current CBP operation, will include the removal of CBP Primary, reconfiguration of six baggage claim devices to four and an expansion of CBP Secondary.
