## 2. Terminal 3: Construction Barricades Removed


- Departures Level barricades in Terminal 3 (central area near escalators to TSA) have been removed following the completion of work on new ticketing counters, which are scheduled to open later this year

### 5. Terminal B: Children's Play Place Re-Opened


- The children's play area in Terminal B (Departures Level past TSA Checkpoint) is re-opened following a week long closure for carpet replacement and other maintenance work
